The control over the Mekong river

1. ***Bearing in mind*** that the Mekong delta is exposed to economic water scarcity,
2. ***Referring*** to the creation of the Mekong river Commission as well as the Mekong river Agreement in 1995,
3. ***Acknowledging*** the importance of hydropower as a renewable energy source for new economically developed countries and developing countries,
4. ***Deploring*** the social and environmental consequences of dam construction on local population downstream such as the deterioration of their economic source of incomes (fishery and agriculture),
5. ***Noting with deep concern*** that climate change is an adding factor to the potential outbreak of water wars undermining the region's stability,
6. ***Stressing all*** countries surrounding the Mekong to engage in negotiations by forming a coalition,
7. ***Seeking*** for a supranational entity intervention to control risks with regard to the environment and the sustainable economic development of local populations.
