Climate change and globalisation

1. **Bearing in mind** that the Paris Agreement has been adopted by 195 countries at the COP21 meeting, which aims to stop using fossil fuels and to fight global warming below 2 degrees celsius,
2. **Alarmed** by the increasing temperatures in the last ten years and the projected 7 degrees that will be added to the world's temperature over the next century,
3. **Recognizing** that climate change is an urgent threat to human societies, the CO2 emissions are harming many lives,
4. **Acknowledging** that universal cooperation is needed to fight climate change, and thus it is important to promote access to sustainable energy in developing countries,
5. **Keeping in mind** that new advances in technology, ideas, cultures at an international level has benefitted countries on an economic scale,
6. **Taking into consideration** the fact that many citizens blame globalisation for unemployment, inequality and terrorism across the world,
7. **Believing** that a global response could prevent globalisation from turning into a problem, seeing as it is one of the main reasons for CO2 emissions:
